






















Istation Home for Parents

Domain name format is school.district.state (e.g., mcnair.dallas.tx).</p> <p><i>If you have students at different campuses, they will need to log in under different domains. Type in the following login information: Username: config Password: config Enter the correct campus or domain for the student logging in. Then click OK. 2. Lexile® – Find A Book

ISIP™ Reading comprehension scores are now correlated to Lexile reader measures. Students are given a Lexile score every time they take the ISIP comprehension subtest. To find books that are in the range of your child’s reading ability use the Find A Book link. [Find A Book >>](#)
